Updating students Health Records

Please return the following forms to enable me to update your child's health records:

- Student Health History Form
- Any New Students entering the district must have a completed health physical examination by a physician within 30 days
- Any recent immunizations or physical examination forms
- Reminder notes have been sent home to the parents of the children who are in need of immunizations

It is suggested by the state health department that a physical be done at each child's developmental stage.

Returning this information will help me to keep your students records up to the standards of the state health department.

October

Screenings will begin starting with Pre-K and progressing to the higher grades. Screenings will consist of height, weight, vision, hearing, and blood pressure. If a student fails one of the screenings a note will be sent home.

November

Screenings in progress for height, weight, vision, hearing, and blood pressure

Reminder notes have been sent home to the parents of the children who are in need of immunization. Please complete these required immunizations because the yearly report will soon be sent to the NJ Department of Health.

December

Screenings in progress for height, weight, vision, hearing, and blood pressure. Referrals were sent home to any child who failed any of the screenings.

January

Notification for Scoliosis Screenings go home with students to be signed by parents for permission. Please return the form as soon as possible. Screening will take place next month.

April/May

Letters to go home for fifth grade students for Tdap and Meningococcal vaccines to enter sixth grade.
